we are fortunate to announce again for 2016 the pilgrimage to the Four Holy Places in India and Nepal.

Every year the pilgrimage is organized well and qualified by Bikash, a longstanding Nepalese student of Most Ven. Ajarn Tong. The accommodation will be in hotels as well as in temples. There will be a 10-days meditation retreat in the birthplace of the Buddha. Who from our senior teachers will accompany the journey and teach the retreat besides Ven. Phrakhrubhavanabidhan (Phra Ajarn Ofer) will be announced later. Please note that participants need to have finished the Basic Course or at least have attended a several days retreat in one of our centers.

The journey is a wonderful possibility to get to know the historical places where the Buddha lived and operated and it is considered to be a very meritorious act if it is undertaken with the right intention and understanding.

People are supposed to meet Bikash the tour organizer in Delhi. Everybody is responsible to take care and apply for the Indian visa by oneself in advance. Best is to apply for it in the home country. The Nepalese visa will be applied upon arrival at the border.

People who like to do another retreat in Thailand, can afterwards continue the travel together with part of the group to Thailand and go to our main monastery Wat Phradhatu Sri Chomtong.

^{* &}lt;u>Please note</u>: The teachers have to pay international and domestic flights as well as the expenses for rooms, transport and food. Bikash charges them a reduced fee, so the expenses are covered without making any profit. Usually when teachers are invited for courses, the costs for flights etc. will be covered through donations of the participants. The USD 100 is a contribution to these expenses, but depending on the number of participants will only cover approximately the full expenses of one teacher.

- Not included are the two domestic flights (Delhi/Gaya, Gaya/ Varanasi); please advice with Samaneri Silavaddhani which flights to book, so everybody is in the same flight.
- Please mention upon registration if you wish an extra option like single room in retreat or during all the trip.
- Room costs in Delhi for people arriving before February 7th: USD 40 (single), USD 20 (double);
 please mention upon registration if you need a room in Delhi.
- For registration it is necessary to pay a deposit of USD 500. Bank details will be supplied later.

Included:

Not included:

- International airfare from country of residence to Delhi and back from Kathmandu (respectively the onward travel to Thailand)
- Domestic flight Delhi/Gaya, Gaya/Varanasi
- Accomodation in Delhi (if somebody arrives before 07.02.)
- Personal expenses such as laundry, telephone calls, camera fee etc.
- Entrance fees
- Tips for drivers, porters, guide etc.
- Donation for teacher and temples
- Anything not specifically mentioned under inclusions
- Any type of insurance
- International Airport Tax
- Additional sightseeing or usages of vehicle not mentioned in the itinerary
